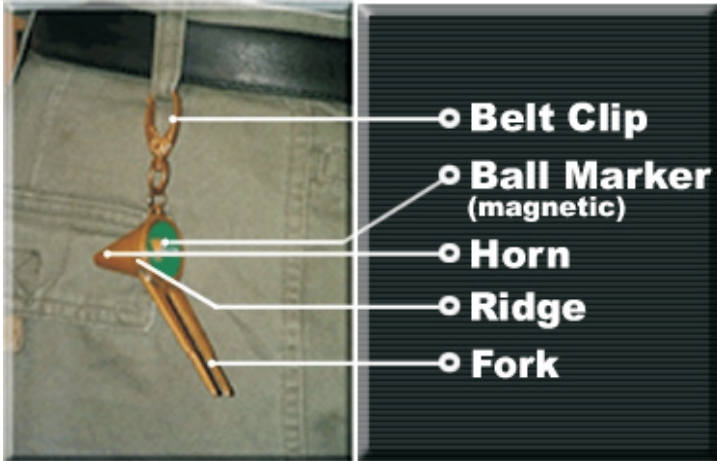




A "Sportsman" should leave a perfect green for his fellow Golfers!



Rhinodivot
Is as essential for greens as a sandbag is for fairways.

The conventional way:



When a divot is formed, the grass is often permanently damaged by the impact of the golf ball. Conventional divot repair forks do not repair the damaged grass and it may take a few weeks for new grass to appear.

The RHINO way:



- A) Removes the damaged grass, replacing it with healthy turf.
- B) Can be used on all divots (old and new). Therefore you will have perfect greens.
- C) Leaving no trace of the divot.
- D) Takes only five seconds to use.

STEP ONE

Insert the prongs of the fork into the divot (pitch mark), to a depth of about 2cm & lift the compacted turf slightly to loosen it.



STEP TWO

Press the horn downwards onto the divot, pushing the damaged turf into the soil below the surrounding healthy turf.



STEP THREE

Insert the prongs of the fork into the healthy turf surrounding the divot about 1cm from the edge of the the divot, at an angle of approximately 45 degrees.



STEP FOUR

Lever the fork toward the divot, filling in the divot with healthy turf. **Then repeat the exercise from the opposite side of the divot**



STEP FIVE

Level the surface with your putter leaving no trace of the divot.
